

Pursuant to the Article 82 paragraph 1 item 3 of the Constitution of Montenegro and Amendment IV paragraph 1 to the Constitution of Montenegro, the Parliament of Montenegro of the 26th Convocation, at the Second Sitting of the First Ordinary (Spring) Session in 2018, on 19 March 2018, adopted the

DECISION

**ON AMENDMENTS TO THE RULES OF PROCEDURE OF
THE PARLIAMENT OF MONTENEGRO**

Article 1

In the Rules of Procedure of the Parliament of Montenegro (Official Gazette of the Republic of Montenegro 51/06 and 66/06 and Official Gazette of Montenegro 88/09, 80/10, 39/11, 25/12, 49/13, 32/14, 42/15 and 52/17), Article 178 is hereby amended as follows:

"Number of nominees for the election of members of the Judicial Council from among respectable lawyers, shall be as needed to be elected.

Number of nominees for the election of members of the Prosecutorial Council from among respectable lawyers, by rule shall be as needed to be elected.

The motion for election of members of the Judicial Council and members of the Prosecutorial Council from among respectable lawyers, and appointment of officials, shall be subject to opening of a debate.

After the completion of the debate, open voting shall proceed, and each nominated candidate shall be decided on individually."

Article 2

This Decision shall enter into force on the eighth day following that of its publication in the Official Gazette of Montenegro.
